

Endowment Levels

Some gifts could be matched by funds made available from the NC State Natural Resources Foundation, Inc or other sources to greater enhance your giving potential.

Undergraduate/Professional Scholarship Award to provide partial support for a CNR student in an undergraduate. Minimum \$ 15,000

Endowed Fund - a named fund to provide annual income to support various needs and objectives such as research, internships, summer camp, and travel abroad. Minimum \$ 15,000

Undergraduate/Professional Scholarship to support a named scholarship for a CNR student in an undergraduate. Minimum \$ 25,000

Merit Awards Program Scholarship to provide a merit/no-need scholarship for an entering CNR freshman to recognize exceptional academic ability and talent. Minimum \$ 50,000

CNR Caldwell Alumni Scholarship to provide an annual stipend for a student on the basis of demonstrated leadership potential, outstanding scholarship, citizenship, intellectual promise. Minimum \$100,000

Graduate Fellowship Fund to provide partial support for CNR students in a graduate program. Minimum \$100,000

Graduate Fellowship to provide support for a CNR student in a graduate program. Minimum \$300,000

Faculty Fellows Fund to provide income and recognition for promising young CNR faculty scholars at pivotal points in their careers. Minimum \$300,000

Associate Professorship Fund to reward and encourage a gifted CNR teacher or scholar early in his/her career. Minimum \$500,000

Endowed Professorship to provide income, teaching and research support for an eminent CNR scholar. Minimum \$1,000,000

Endowed Chair to create a new CNR faculty position including salary, benefits, research funds, space, etc. Minimum \$2,500,000

Institutes, Programs and Centers - At least three quarters of the endowment must be unrestricted to ensure flexibility for the overall enhancement of the CNR institute, program or center. Minimum \$1,000,000

Academic Department: - At least three quarters of the endowment must be unrestricted to ensure flexibility for the overall enhancement of the CNR academic department
Minimum \$10,000,000

College of Natural Resources - At least three quarters of the endowment must be unrestricted to ensure flexibility for the overall enhancement of CNR. Minimum \$25,000,000

CNR Dean's Initiative Fund to provide unrestricted annual income to support initiatives by the CNR Dean. Minimum \$ 1,000,000
