Grainger Barrett is County Attorney for Cumberland County, N.C. During his career, he has been County Attorney for Person County, Town Attorney for the Town of Chapel Hill, and Assistant Professor of Public Law and Government at the Institute of Government, as well as an attorney for a New York law firm and an in-house counsel for Liggett Group, Inc. He initiated and is co-manager for LGLaw, a website and listserv [<http://www.sog.unc.edu/organizations/lglaw/index.html>] for county attorneys, city attorneys and others interested in local government ["LG"] law. He has taught on public law for the public's lawyers, ethics and free speech for government lawyers, basics of

contracting, legal advice for environmental health personnel, sexual harassment, facilities liability in recreation activities, legal liability for swimming pool operations, risk management for recreation departments, the sales article of the Uniform Commercial Code, employment and discrimination claims for supervisors, diversity in the workplace, and effective writing. He is Second Vice President of the N. C. Association of County Attorneys, and a Councilmember of the Environment, Energy and Natural Resources Section of the North Carolina Bar Association. He is an active member of the Friends of the School of Government. He has an A.B. and J.D. from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
